



ASSISTANT PROFESSOR TENURE TRACK ARTS EDUCATION (DANCE EDUCATION)

The Faculty of Education, University of Regina is inviting applications for a Full-time, Tenure-Track Position appointment beginning July 1, 2014.

The Faculty of Education seeks an individual who can contribute to the Arts Education Program, with a focus in Dance Education. The Faculty has a strong orientation towards social justice issues in education and is committed to enacting the themes, vision, values and mission of the University's Strategic Plan - *mâmawohkamâtowin*: Our Work, Our People, Our Communities. Consistent with this orientation, the Arts Education Program supports students to critically engage with arts education practices in K-12 educational settings. The program also offers a Certificate in Dance Teacher Education for those who wish to teach in dance studios or community settings.

Duties:

The Arts Education Program offers students the opportunity to major and minor in the five arts disciplines of Dance, Drama, Literature, Music and Visual Art. Additionally students are able to obtain a second degree in their major area. The individual will be responsible to teach undergraduate and graduate classes in Arts Education (Dance Education) and Educational Core Studies, supervise undergraduate students in field experiences, supervise graduate students, assume active involvement in Faculty endeavours and engage in individual and collaborative scholarly research. The individual should be able to teach both dance content classes (dance technique, history, notation and choreography) and dance pedagogy classes.

Qualifications:

The successful applicant should possess a Ph.D. degree or the equivalent with an academic focus on Dance Education, Arts Education. K-12 and University teaching experience level is preferred. The individual should bring research, teaching and creative strengths to the position, with evidence of research informing practice and vice versa, as well as knowledge of teacher education program design and function. A willingness to participate and contribute fully in all aspects of the Arts Education program and other functions at the University is required.
